WHEN DOES THE P&C MEET?

- We host the "Coffee Club" on Thursday of week 6 of every term at 9am - we hear about a topic from the school and provide an update on the P&C.

WHAT HAPPENS AT A P&C MEETING?

- The Principal's Report - Mrs Comminos updates the P&C on happenings at the school, upcoming programmes and initiatives for students & staff
- General Meeting - We discuss upcoming events and initiatives, get reports from the different subcommittees. All parents can send ideas prior to the meeting for discussion and consideration.
